You are invited to submit titles and abstracts for papers to be presented at the SE-EPPC 10th Annual Symposium. Volunteer papers may be presented orally or as a poster. The symposium will emphasize, but is not restricted to, presentations that address the theme **Managing Invasive Plants in Disturbed Landscapes**. Research papers concerning how invasive plants respond to natural and man-made disturbances or how local communities and stakeholders take action to anticipate and respond to the increased threats posed by invasive non-native plants following disturbances are encouraged to participate.

Deadline

Abstracts must be submitted electronically by **March 1, 2008** to be considered. Send the paper’s title, author(s), and the abstract to John Madsen at jmadsen@gri.msstate.edu. Finished abstracts, ready for publication of the proceedings, must be submitted by **March 15** for both invited and offered presentations and posters. All vital information will be welcomed in a brief or extended abstract for publication of the proceedings that will be distributed at the conference.

Abstracts should include the title, author(s), author(s), affiliation(s), and one paragraph of text. Extended abstracts of up to 500 words will be accepted. Send the abstract as an MS Word or ASCII text file.

Only Powerpoint Presentations in MS Windows format will be accepted for oral presentations, unless prior permission is obtained from the program chair. Powerpoint files will be requested before the meeting. Authors of abstracts accepted for presentation will be contacted with presentation submission details. All poster and oral paper presenters will be expected to register for the conference.
