



## Alabama Invasive Plant Council 13<sup>th</sup> Annual Conference

The Alabama Invasive Plant Council invites you to its 13<sup>th</sup> Annual Invasive Plant Conference, to be held at Wind Creek Hotel (<http://windcreekatmore.com/Directions>) in Atmore, Alabama. This one day meeting will include talks and field workshops on the biology and control of cogongrass, Chinese tallowtree, Chinese privet, Japanese climbing fern and several other troublesome plants.

An *optional* field tour of nearby Splinter Hill Bog Preserve, which will be at peak flowering for many species, will be led by Fred Nation on Friday morning. We will leave the hotel at 8 am, arrive at 8:30 or so, and spend about two hours on site. To date, the preserve has not been invaded to any extent by invasive plants, although cogongrass and several other species are in the vicinity.

Who should attend: This meeting will be of interest to a wide range of people including foresters, horticultural professionals, natural areas managers, and Government agency personnel.
